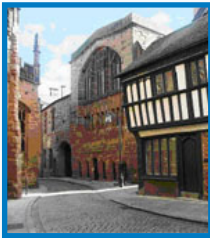

Surgical Training Centre



The Surgical Training Centre has been created to support regional, national and international surgical training. It provides the ideal environment for surgeons to learn operative techniques on cadaveric material in realistic operating theatres. It can cater for arthroscopic and endoscopic as well as open surgery on any part of the body.

The large surgical room is set up with eight operating stations, each one simulating a self-contained operating theatre. Every station includes a bespoke mobile operating table with electric height adjustment, integrated fluid drainage, and interchangeable radiolucent table tops for different types of surgery.
